1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 read with Article 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of show cause notice dated 22.11.2023.
2. Amended Memo of Parties is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner was issued passport on 27.05.2011. An FIR No. 101 dated 28.09.2012, under Sections 18/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, was registered against him at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar City. He left for UK after getting visa on 04.03.2013. In the aforesaid FIR, he was declared Proclaimed Offender. He filed CRM-M- 12716 of 2023 before this Court seeking setting aside of PO
