In this writ petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of corrigendum (Annexure P-3) i.e. Explanation (ii), wherein it has been held that the dependents of Ex-Servicemen are not entitled to get benefits under Ex-Serviceman quota.

2. Respondent-Union Territory, Chandigarh has filed its reply wherein it is stated that Union Territory, Chandigarh has decided to follow the provisions as contained in Punjab Recruitment of Ex-serviceman Rules, 1982 which provides that Ex-servicemen also includes lineal descendent. On this basis, it is stated that the dependents of Ex-Serviceman would also get the same benefit. In the reply, it is further stated that as per the written examination conducted, all the eligible candidates were called for interview and the names thereof are mentioned in Annexure R-1.

In view of above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to do the selection in accordance therewith and consider the cases of the dependents of all Ex-Servicemen under the said rules, as

expeditiously as possible and in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. If any further grievance is left, the petitioner can always approach the Court.
